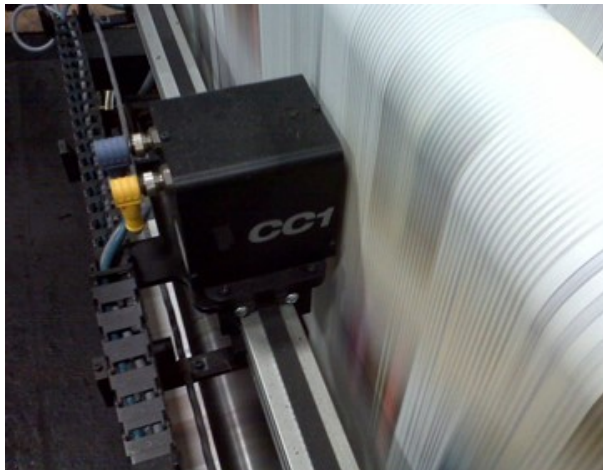


Newsday reports increased color capacity and makeready cost reduction for short job runs with installation of eXaminer II.
